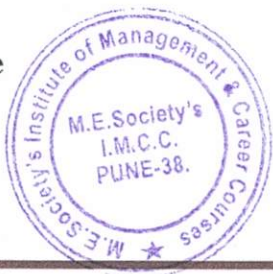

Over all 100+ participants attended the conference.

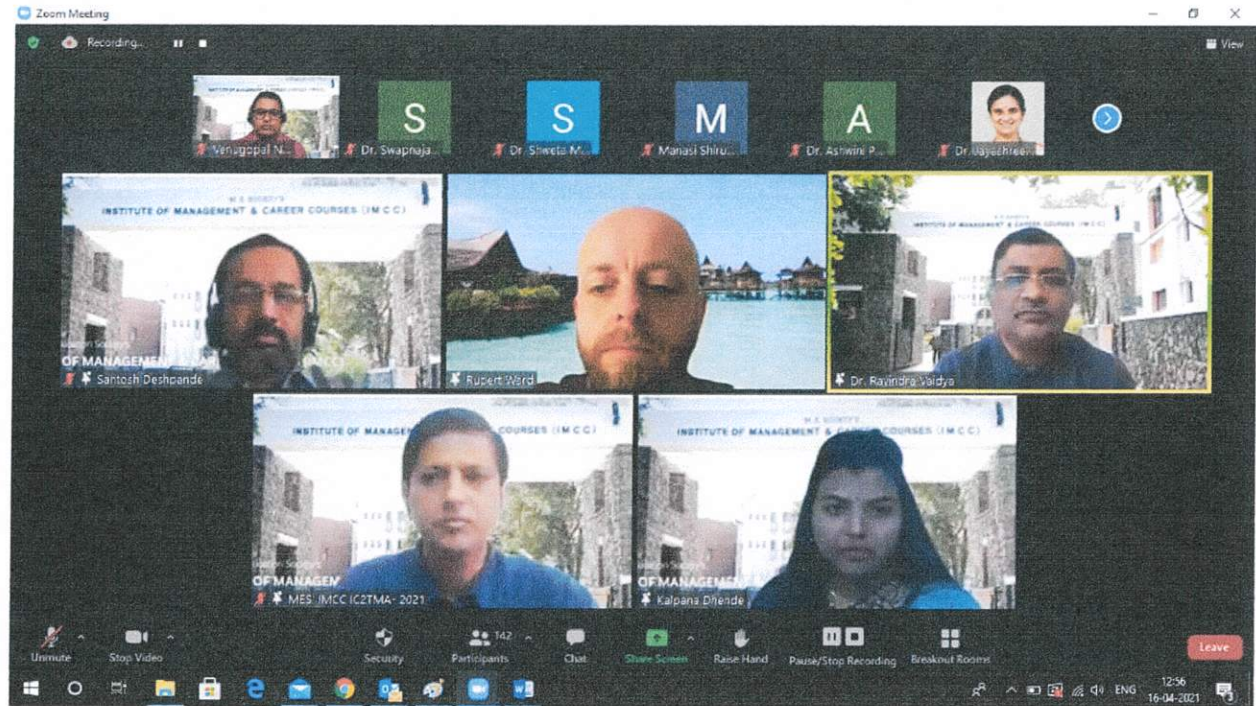

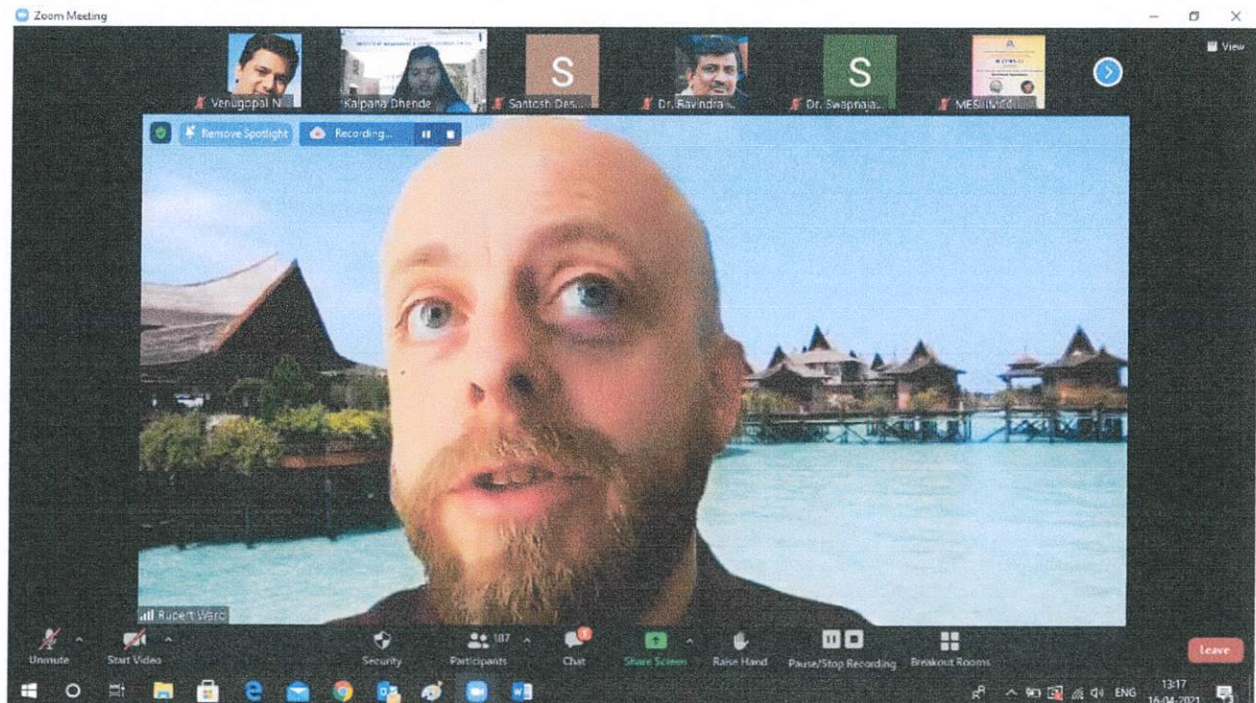

The Modern Management Industry and People Analytics employ research to assess the viability of their operations since it is necessary for a business to understand what its customers want; similarly, research aids in the knowledge of customer desires and the reduction of risk and losses. Businesses may utilize research to determine whether now is the best time to expand into a new city or whether they require a loan. It could also help small businesses figure out whether or not a procedure needs to be changed.

Quantitative research is more reliable and objective in assessing students and lessons as data is obtained after lessons have been taught. The data obtained is mostly on the scores of students after an exercise or assignment. The data is analyzed using tables, graphs, equations and so on. Sir highlighted various quantitative techniques during the two days session. Around 37 students from MBA first year attended the session.

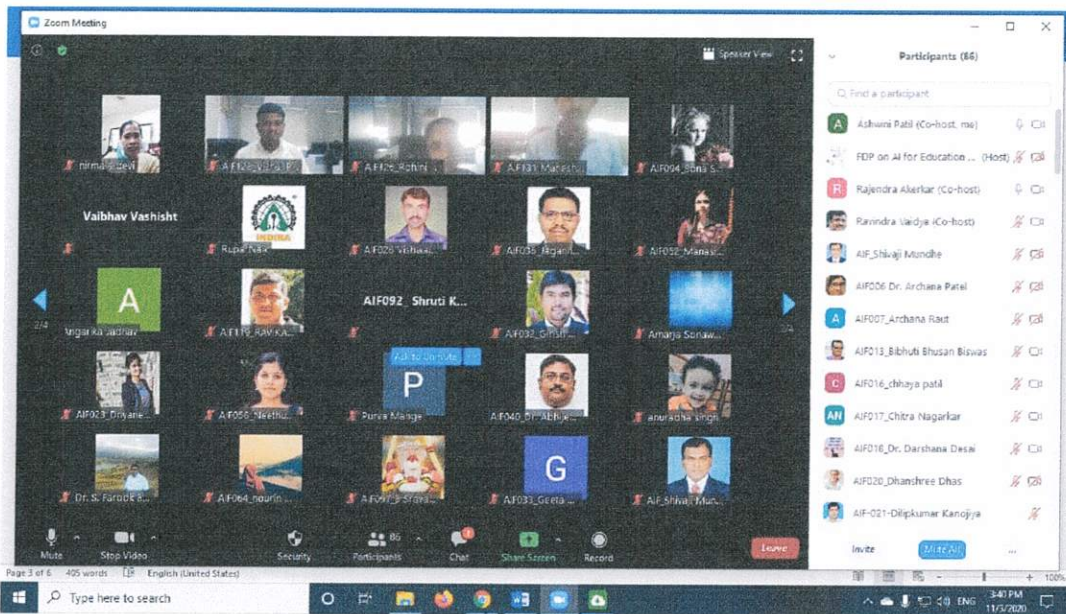

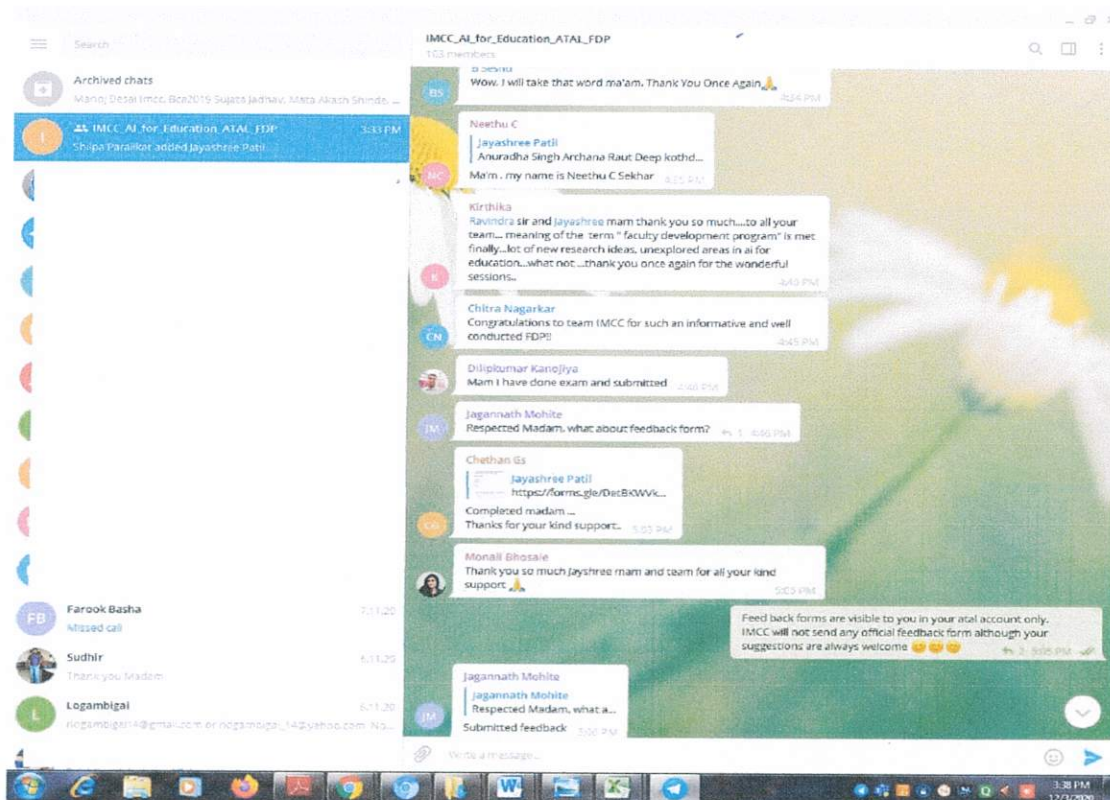
