Plagiarism is when an author uses another person's idea and disseminates it as if it's his or her own idea. It is a form of academic dishonesty and a grave intellectual offense.

In research writing, avoiding plagiarism is important because once you submit a paper that is flagged as plagiarized, it will cost you significantly. For students, this could mean a failing grade, and for professional researchers, this could adversely affect their reputation and credibility.

Dr. S.B. Kishor sir discussed the meaning and importance of plagiarism in research and academic writing. He stated the meaning of citation, how citation should be written and different citation styles. 50 Students participated in the session.

Research: Do it Intelligently using tools

Research is an important task of creativity and innovation. Researchers come up with new ideas, observations, solutions for research problems. However, such expected research outcomes do not come at once. No research activity can be successful unless a systematic approach is practiced with dedicated hard work is at the core of it.
