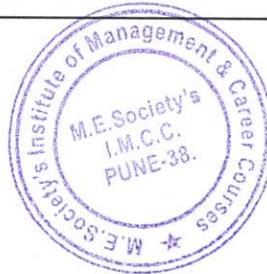

MES IMCC's library and information resource centre is one of the best libraries in the Pune regional Academic Institutions as regard to the services and ICT application. The Library of MES IMCC, Pune was established in the year 1983. The period from 1996 and onwards can be considered as the metamorphosis period for the IMCC Library. Library has focused on the *embedded librarianship model* and thus the purpose of a library is to disseminate knowledge by providing customized library service packages especially to the faculty members and research scholars. auto transaction mode for the Library Documents Transaction purpose through the effective use of bar coded collection and in-house generated ID cards & Borrowers' Tickets. The library is also focused on the use of social networking aspects such as blogs (Web ID: <http://mesimcclibrary.blogspot.in/>) and Whatsapp medium for creating effective communication with the users.

The work includes knowledge organization as well as preparation of databases, data migration is been done before the launching of common OPAC. The lecture started with basics and gradually moved to more advanced topics like the math mode, array and equations, etc. and ended with a brief on class files.

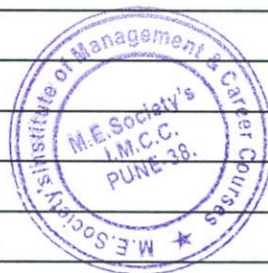

Research: Do it Intelligently using tools

Research is an important task of creativity and innovation. Researchers come up with new ideas, observations, solutions for research problems. However, such expected research outcomes do not come at once. No research activity can be successful unless a systematic approach is practiced with dedicated hard work is at the core of it.

Various phases that comprise research activity involves finalization of research problem statement, extensive literature survey, experimentation, writing, reference management, publish and present etc. Although all these activities are significant, a researcher cannot afford spending lot of energy and time in these phases.
