

HR analytics plays a very important role in forming strategies as it facilitates strategic decision making for the betterment of the organization. HR analytics helps in quantifying the complex and qualitative data. It enables measuring the performance of the employees in comprehensive manner.

Organisation has two main objectives viz. Maximization and Minimization. Various methods included in HR analytics like regression, co-relation, decision tree, operation research organization to take decisions on collected data. Types of analyzing data are descriptive, diagnostic, predictive, prescriptive.

Further, the session covered difference between metrics and analytics, six categories that should be covered in metrics (quantity, quality, time, money, satisfaction, comparison number). Also, four components of balanced scorecard viz. finance, customers, internal business processes and learning and growth. Balanced scorecard includes major goals of the organization. HR Analytics helps in measuring those goals. Goals of lower level and middle level management can be aligned with the goals of the organization by establishing KRIs and KPIs. Case study on attrition prediction was also discussed with the help of SPSS software.



Session 2: Dr. Shailesh Kasande

The session begins with an overview of analytics tools and what participants are already familiar with. He discusses the Deviation Function, the Chi Square Test, and the 2*2 Matrices. He also provides some practical examples of how various tools can be used in various domains such as HR, Finance, Marketing, and so on, as well as give hands-on experience with SPSS and explains the logic behind the results.

The session had assisted participants in connecting impending problems with independently generated new information in their research field.





Further, the accounts of the institute will be open for test check by the Council or Controller & Auditor General of India or any other officer designated by them.
 - (c) The amount of the Grant-in-Aid bill shall be disbursed and credited to the account of INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT & CAREER COURSES through RTGS.
 - (d) This Grant-in-Aid is being released in conformity with the terms & conditions as well as norms of the scheme as already communicated vide the scheme document.
 - (e) The sanctioned grant-in-aid is debitable to the ATAL's FDP scheme and is valid for payment during the <u>financial year 2023-24</u> only.
